Course Objective

The Minor Award in Managing a Childcare Service is aimed at practising Early Years Educators who are managers of childcare settings or who wish to become managers. This course will increase and formalise practitioner's knowledge regarding setting up a small business, funding applications, policy drafting, people management and basic Early Years curriculum planning, employment and Children's Law.

The course consists of four 25 hour modules. To facilitate practitioners, each module will be delivered in the evenings on a flexible basis. It is envisaged to deliver two modules between September and the end of November and the remaining two modules between January and March.
