



Kerry Local Sports Partnership (Kerry LSP) Scholarship

Kerry LSP is inviting students from Institute of Technology Tralee (ITT) to apply for a scholarship for the academic year 2008/2009. The aim of providing this scholarship is to select a student who can represent the Institute in their sport, as a coach or player, while also being an ambassador for Kerry LSP.

It is the mission of Kerry LSP to enable the ongoing development of quality sporting and active recreational opportunities throughout Kerry in an environment that promotes healthy lifestyles, maximum participation and achievement.

Criteria for Eligibility

Applicants for the Kerry LSP scholarship must be full time undergraduate students in good academic standing and a proven record of involvement in playing, coaching or managing their sport.

Scholarship Requirements

The successful Scholarship recipients will be expected to contribute to the Kerry LSP strategic plan by:

- Helping to promote the represented sport within ITT and Kerry
- Helping to improve performance standards participants of this sport within ITT and Kerry
- Helping to plan, organise and deliver targeted sports events & activities for this sport

The Scholarship recipient will work along with Kerry LSP staff on a specified programme of work relating to the Scholarship area. This will be planned and agreed in advance with each Scholarship recipient. Clearly defined roles and responsibilities and an outline of the time commitment (equivalent of 1 hour a week across the academic year) required will be provided.

Further involvement with the Kerry LSP will be at the student's discretion.

A fund of €1,000 will be awarded in line with ITT scholarship procedures. Kerry LSP reserves the right to prioritise applicants from minority sport.
